If excellence is necessary for America to continue to compete in the global economy, then there is much work to be done in preparing the next generation of professionals to enter the workplace. The survey data states that only 23.9 % of new entrants with a four-year college degree have "excellent basic knowledge, applied skills and important

deficiencies exist among entrants at entry level and greatest at the high school level with 42.4 % of employees reporting the overall


